Dear Mayor Bell,

We, the members of the Durham Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Commission (DBPAC), express our support for the recent petition from the Friends of West Point on the Eno, Inc. for the completed construction of the following projects:

- 1) The Eno River Greenway,
- 2) The Eno River Pedestrian and Bicycle Bridge, and
- 3) The Lower Warren Creek Greenway.

It has come to our attention that the schedule for the Eno River Pedestrian and Bicycle Bridge is especially important. Before the bridge can be built, a cement causeway must be removed. Durham must use the funding for the removal of the causeway before June, or the funding will be lost. We request your attention to this matter and ask you to take steps to ensure that this project moves forward on schedule.

Along with the Eno River Bridge, the Eno River and Lower Warren Creek Greenways are the only planned trails connecting the area north of I-85 with the Durham Greenway and Trails System. Considering that these projects are in the budget and on our bicycle maps, we request that these projects be completed as soon as possible.

DBPAC appreciates your continued support of bike and pedestrian facilities improvement.
